

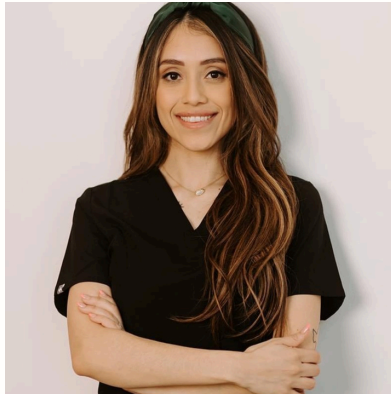

Roy Lackey

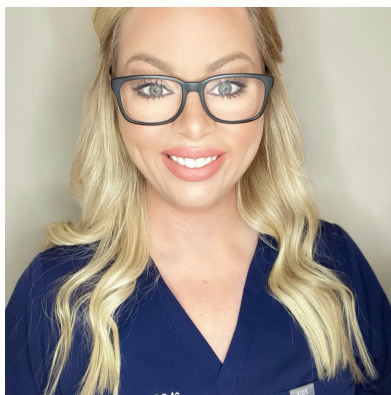
